1922-1961

1922

A Woman's Error - Directed by Tressie Souders

Considered the first film to be directed by a black woman in the United States.

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1923

Flames of Wrath - Directed by Maria P. Williams

Othello - Directed by Liz White

The film was shot between 1962 and 1966, but it wasn't completed and screened until 1980.

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1981

Will - Directed by Jessie Maple

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1982

Losing Ground - Directed by Kathleen Collins Prettyman

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1989

Twice as Nice - Directed by Jessie Maple

The first African American woman to direct two feature films.

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Leola: Love Your Mama - Directed by Ruby Oliver

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From Rags to Reality - Directed by Joy Shannon/Joy S'hani Ache

The first feature by an African American woman to receive a home video release. The name of the film was changed to Uptown Angel for the video release.

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A Dry White Season - Directed by Euzhan Palcy

The French director from Martinique became the first women of African descent to direct a feature film produced by a major Hollywood studio.

Trouble I've Seen - Directed by Heather Foxworth, M.D.

The Three Mustakels - Directed by Romell Foster-Owens

1991

Daughters of the Dust - Directed by Julie Dash

The first feature directed by an African American woman to receive national theatrical distribution.

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1992

Alma's Rainbow - Directed by Ayoka Chenzira

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Kiss Grandmama Goodbye - Directed by Debra Robinson

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1993

Just Another Girl on the IRT - Directed by Leslie Harris

Distributed by Miramax it is the first feature by an African American woman to be distributed by a major theatrical distributor.

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The Gifted - Directed by Audrey Lewis

The first sci-fi feature by an African American woman.

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1994

I Like It Like That - Directed by Darnell Martin

The first African American woman to direct a feature film produced by a major Hollywood studio.

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Naked Acts - Directed by Bridgett Davis

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The Promised Land - Directed by Monika Harris

Medipaid Queens - Directed by Karen Stone, M.D.

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1996

Girlfriends - Directed by Marlies Carruth

The Watermelon Woman - Directed by Cheryl Dunye

The first feature film directed by an "out" African American lesbian about African American lesbians.

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1997

Eve's Bayou - Directed by Kasi Lemmons

The top grossing independent film of 1997.
